<b>Complete Assessment**</b> <i>(If Applicable)</i> Assessment or placement scores may be waived if your high school or college GPA is 3.0 or higher, or if you have met placement with the ACT or Accuplacer. It is important that all transcripts are sent for review to determine if assessments are needed.**	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Complete Chemistry</b> <i>(NWTC Catalog #10806134)</i> Chemistry is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school chemistry with lab with a C or greater or college level chemistry with a C or greater.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>Complete General Anatomy &amp; Physiology</b> <i>(NWTC Catalog #10806177)</i> Students must earn a B or greater in college level general anatomy & physiology.	<input type="checkbox"/>
