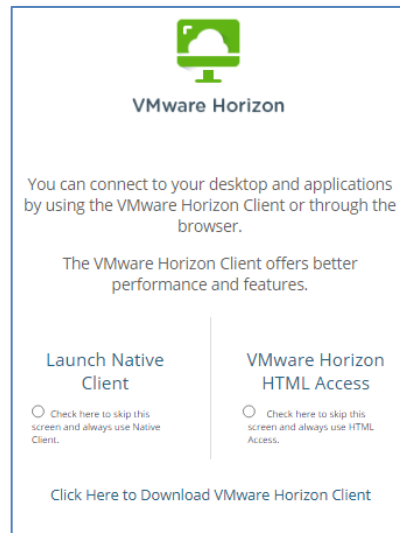




How to Connect to your Virtual Machine from a Web Browser

Note: HTML access does not support USB connections

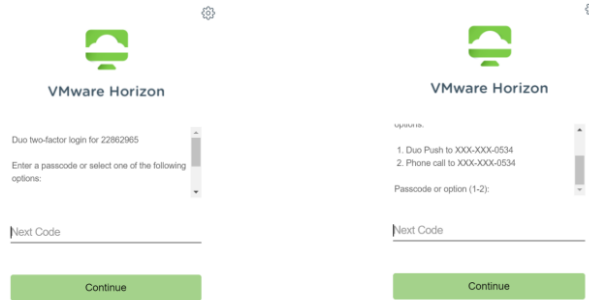
1. Navigate via a web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, Safari) to the following website <https://vdi.nwtc.edu/>
2. Click **VMware Horizon HTML Access**



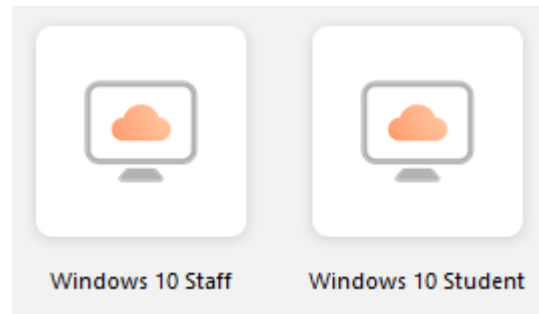
3. Click **Accept** on User Agreement
