DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Establish relationships with professional organizations** such as the Center for Integrated Agriculture Systems, Michael Fields Agricultural Institute, Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education, University of Wisconsin Extension Innovation Center, and Wisconsin Department of Agriculture is essential.
- **Coordinate the development of curriculum** for an organic agriculture certificate program intended for farmers considering and/or transitioning to organic farming.
