This online version of CultureGrams includes World, Kids, United States, and Canadian Provinces modules. It provides an insider perspective on the daily life and culture, including the background, customs and lifestyles of the world's people.

### ACCESSING CULTUREGRAMS

1. **On campus:** from the Library home page [www.nwtc.edu/library](http://www.nwtc.edu/library) select CultureGrams from the Online Databases list.
2. **Off campus:** from the Library home page [www.nwtc.edu/library](http://www.nwtc.edu/library) select CultureGrams from the Online Databases list. You must be a Northeast Wisconsin Technical College student or employee. Please enter your student or employee ID number to verify your affiliation with the College. If you do not know this number, please contact the Library at 920-498-5493 or use the email portion of [Ask-A-Librarian](#).

### WORLD EDITION

1. Select a region or country from the drop-down list at the top of the screen, the [Accessible country index](#), or click on a section of the world map.
2. Each country report includes a map, background information, and sections on the people, customs and courtesies, lifestyle, and society. Additional links are provided to a currency converter, the recipe collection and famous people.
3. Click on [View full report as PDF](#) to access a version of the full report that you can save, print, or download.
4. The [Graphs and Tables](#) feature allows you to develop comparison tables for countries with a variety of statistical categories.

### KIDS EDITION

1. Select a region or country from the drop-down list at the top of the screen, the [Accessible country index](#), or click on a section of the world map.
2. Country information includes a map, people and places, history, lifestyle, society, fun facts and contacts sections. Additional links are provided to the recipe collection and famous people.
3. Click on [View full report as PDF](#) to access a version of the full report that you can save, print, or download.
4. The [Graphs and Tables](#) feature allows you to develop comparison tables for countries with a variety of statistical categories, or select from prepared tables of information listed on the left side of the screen.

### STATES EDITION

1. Select a state from the drop-down list at the top of the screen, the [Accessible state index](#), or click on a section of the United States map.
2. State information includes a map, flag, motto, did you know, the place, history, the people, fun facts and contacts sections.
3. Click on [View full report as PDF](#) to access a version of the full report that you can save, print, or download.
4. The [Graphs and Tables](#) feature allows you to select from prepared tables of information on all the states OR create-your-own-comparison tables by selecting the states and a variety of statistical categories.



## PROVINCES EDITION

1. Select a province from the drop-down list at the top of the screen, the **Accessible province index**, or click on a section of the Canada map.
2. Province information includes a map, flag, did you know, the place, history, people, cultural notes, fun facts, and contacts sections.
3. Click on **View full report as PDF** to access a version of the full report that you can save, print, or download.
4. The **Graphs and Tables** feature allows you to select from prepared tables of information on all the provinces OR create-your-own-comparison tables by selecting the provinces and a variety of statistical categories.

- **Photo Gallery** – provides photos from around the world.
- **Famous people** – includes short biographies on countries best-known people.
- **Recipe collection** – provides five native recipes from each country.
