ACCESSING ENCYCLOPAEDIA BRITANNICA

1. **On campus:** from the Library home page www.nwtc.edu/library select Encyclopedia Britannica from the Online Databases list.
2. **Off campus:** from the Library home page www.nwtc.edu/library select Encyclopedia Britannica from the Online Databases list. You must be a Northeast Wisconsin Technical College student or employee. Please enter your student or employee ID number to verify your affiliation with the College. If you do not know this number, please contact the Library at 920-498-5493 or use the email portion of [Ask-A-Librarian](#).

STANDARD SEARCH

1. Type a word or phrase in the search box. Select either Encyclopaedia Britannica Online or Merriam-Webster Dictionary & Thesaurus.
2. Click .
3. The next page will provide an overview of the different results that match your query. Select one of the resources or try another search.

ADVANCED SEARCH – Allows you to construct a more detailed search strategy.


1. Type in words or phrases in as many search fields as you want.
2. Use the menu on the right to change the number of results (optional).
3. Use the buttons at the bottom of the page to change the default search result.
4. Click .

BROWSING OPTIONS

- **Index** – finds all the references to a topic throughout the encyclopedia.
- **A-Z Browse** – articles are displayed in a traditional alphabetical arrangement.
- **Subject Browse** – articles are organized by topic, allowing you to follow an outline to the subject that interests you.
- **World Atlas** – maps and articles on nations, people, and places from around the globe are located with this feature.
- **Timelines** – selected topics in history are covered with illustrations and key dates.
- **Year In Review Browse** – covers notable events and people of the recent past.
- **World Data** – provides statistical information for countries of the world.
- **Notable Quotes** – includes 4,000 quotes searchable by author or subject.
- **Gateway to the Classics** – provides 225 works by 140 authors searchable by author, title or subject.
- **Britannica Daily** – includes Britannica Highlights, biography of the day, this day in history and news from around the world.



RESULTS LIST OPTIONS

- **Additional Resources** of information will appear in the columns to the left [Choose a content source:](#) and right [MEDIA](#) of the search results.
- **Workspace** - By clicking on the small icon  next to the article title or website, you will be able to save the information in your Workspace. You can collect your research and then return later in the session to review the various articles.
- **Viewing Articles** – Your search results display as a list of article citations that contain the term(s) you entered. Click on the article name to view the full-text of the article.
- **Citing the Article**- The MLA and APA citation formats for the article will appear at the bottom of the screen. You can also click on [CITE ARTICLE](#) above the article.
- **Printing, Emailing, and Saving an Article** – When you are viewing an article, these icons will appear at the top of the screen [SAVE TO WORKSPACE](#) [PRINT PAGE](#) [PRINT ARTICLE](#) [E-MAIL ARTICLE](#)
- **Viewing Accompanying Video or Media Clips** - You will not be able to view the video or media clips unless a plug-in has been loaded on your computer. When you click on the link, you will be asked to select the access speed and either Windows Media Player or Real One Player. If not already on your computer, click on [HELP](#) in the upper right corner, select Videos and then select the free downloads.

NOTES

Other features of Encyclopaedia Britannica Online include:

- **Concise Encyclopedia** – provides brief articles for quick answers.
- **Media** – includes images, sound files and interactive multimedia.
- **Videos** – a collection of more than 2,000 videos clips.
- **Websites** – expands information to include the Internet.
- **Journals and Magazines** – a selection of articles from ProQuest and EBSCOhost databases offers another source of information on your topic.
- **Dictionary and Thesaurus** – includes entries from the Merriam-Webster Collegiate Dictionary and Thesaurus.
- **Quotations** – Provides a collection of 4,000 quotations.
