## Northeast Wisconsin Technical College DENTAL HYGIENE CLINIC CLIENT RIGHTS

Clients seen at the Northeast Wisconsin Technical College Dental hygiene Clinic have a right, within the scope of dental hygiene practice, to:

1. Respect of the individuality, dignity, and rights of every client regardless of race, color, creed, national origin, social or economic status.
2. Professional, confidential client relationships.
3. The provision of preventive, educational and therapeutic procedures to the standard of care of the dental hygiene profession.
4. Protection and respect for personal and property rights of the client. Written permission is required to use client records, photographs or client's name in the classroom or public presentation.
5. Compliance with OSHA requirements and CDC guidelines regarding exposure control for client and operator protection.
6. Provisions for client safety during treatment.
7. Thorough screening of the client's medical background for any medical concerns that would contra-indicate or require modifications in dental hygiene care.
8. Be informed of the uniqueness of the dental hygiene school clinic in reference to:
  - a. Length of appointment
  - b. Faculty supervision
  - c. Fees for services
9. An explanation of recommended and alternative treatments, expected outcomes, and the option to refuse treatment.
10. Be informed of their current oral health status and be given appropriate referrals and recommendations.
11. Access to all clinical assessments and services including any significant information related to the appointment.
12. The completion of agreed upon services for the client within the time frame of one school year. If the treatment cannot be completed by the end of the semester, the student will inform the client.
