The following classes are approved by the State of Wisconsin Division of Children and Family Services and satisfy the entry level training requirements as stated in the description.

### **Child Care Profession-Intro**

**36 hours**

**Catalog # 47-307-447**

Provides entry-level knowledge and skills for individuals as they begin to or intend to care for children in group or family child care. Learners explore rules and regulations governing group and family child care and the responsibilities of child care providers. This course fulfills introductory non-credit course requirements as specified in HFS Chapters 45 and 46 for family group day care in Wisconsin's Administrative Code.

This course is required for individuals wishing to work as an assistant in a child care center. Family Childcare providers also start with this course.

### **Child Care Teacher-Skills/Strategies**

**42 hours**

**47-307-448**

Focuses on skills and strategies for the child care teacher with emphasis on selecting developmentally appropriate activities, planning lessons, and facilitating children's activities. This course meets Wisconsin's requirements for Child Care Teacher.

**Prerequisite: 47-307-447, Child Care Profession Intro.**

This course is required, along with the Introduction to the Child Care Profession course above, if you wish to have "sole" care of children.

### **Fund of Infant/Toddler**

**20 hours**

**47-307-452**

Provides requirements and practices for entry-level childcare providers who are or will work with infants and toddlers. Course fulfills requirements as specified by Wisconsin's State Law. Wisconsin day care regulations require that individuals working with infants and toddlers must complete infant and toddler training within six months of assuming a position.

**Prerequisite: 47-307-447, Child Care Profession Intro.**

This course is required for assistants and caregivers who work with infants and/or toddlers (birth up to age 2).

### **Fund of Family Childcare**

**8 hours**

**47-307-466**

Provides essential information about establishing a family child care and is in accordance with Wisconsin's State Law.

**Prerequisite: 47-307-447, Child Care Profession Intro.**

Family Child Care Providers must take this course in *addition* to Child Care Profession-Intro.

**Payment of these classes will be required at the time of registration.**

**\*Please Note: Fees do not include books or supplies. Fees listed are for the 2008-2009 school year and are subject to change.**

### **"I'm not sure which class or classes to take!"**

Please review the following examples to help you decide:

#### **To work as an assistant in an infant room:**

Take Child Care Profession-Intro AND Infant/Toddler Care Fundamentals.

**To work as a lead teacher in a 3-5 year old room:** Take Child Care Profession-Intro AND Child Care Teacher-Skills/Strategies.

#### **To have a Family Childcare in your home:**

Take Child Care Profession-Intro AND Child Care Family Fundamentals. If you have infants/toddlers in your family child care you would ALSO need Infant/Toddler Care Fundamentals.

#### **To work as a lead teacher in an infant room:**

Take Child Care Profession-Intro, Child Care Teacher-Skills/Strategies, and Infant/Toddler Care Fundamentals.
