Responsible Beverage Service provides training for alcohol beverage sellers, servers, and handlers and meets the requirements of Chapter 125.17(6) of the Wisconsin Statutes requiring applicants for A, B, or C licenses to have completed this beverage server course. Wisconsin Act 259 requires applicants for retail alcohol beverage licenses/permits to complete a mandated responsible beverage server training course as a condition of licensing.

Responsible Beverage Server also meets the training requirements for the sale of tobacco products according to Wisconsin State Statute 134.66
