ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of Northeast Wisconsin (Brown, Calumet, Door, Florence, Fond du Lac, Forest, Kewaunee, Marinette, Manitowoc, Menominee, Oconto, Outagamie, Shawano, Sheboygan and Winnebago counties)
- Be currently enrolled as a full-time student (as defined by the institution) in a two- or four-year degree institution in the above-referenced geographic area
- Be pursuing international studies, related degree(s), certificate(s) or an accredited international study abroad curriculum (business, economics or international studies)
- Have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Have completed 50 percent of requirements for a certificate or degree within the current academic year.

Closing date for the application submission is Friday, Feb. 19, 2010.

Recipients will be notified in writing by Friday, March 12, 2010.

Scholarships will be awarded at the Northeast Wisconsin International Trade Conference on Tuesday, March 30, 2010.

Once awarded, the funds can be used for tuition, books, accredited study abroad programs and classes at any college and will be paid directly to the institution.

AWARD CRITERIA

All applications will be evaluated on the basis of:

- meeting the above eligibility requirements
- academic achievement
- creativity
- neatness

Note: Financial need is not a relevant consideration in the award.

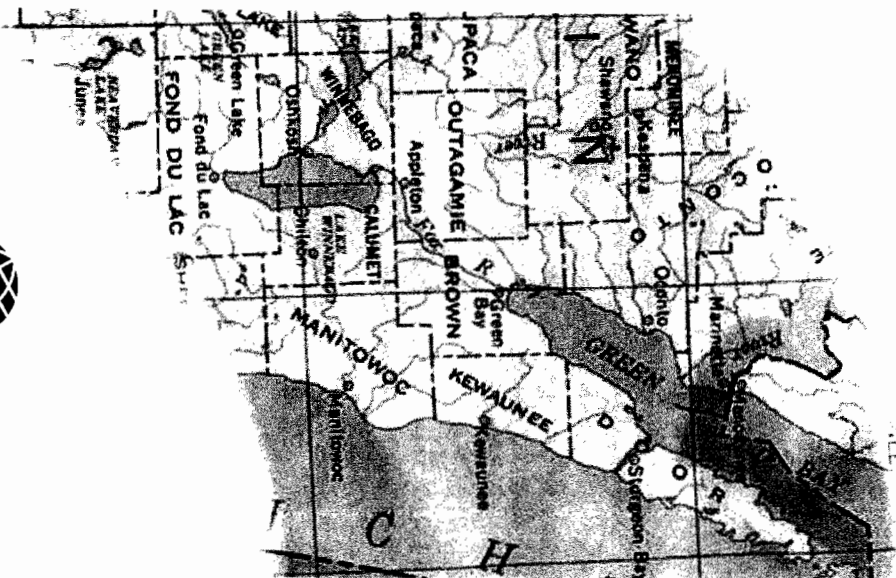
