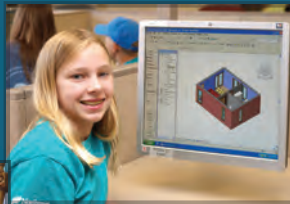

## NWTC Kewaunee - Hillcrest Site

June 21, 22 and 23 • 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

**Cake/Cookie Decorating:** Join us in the kitchen for some cookie baking and decorating of cakes and cookies. Demonstrations and hand-on experience will give you the feel for what it would be like to own your own bake shop. Using various icings, frostings, and tools of the trade, the instructor will provide tips and techniques to make and decorate bakery for all occasions.

**Landscaping Design and Installation:** Plans are important to our ecosystem and yet provide satisfaction and enjoyment for all. In this session, learn the basics about landscape design, plant selection, and the care of all types of gardens. As a team, the group will complete a landscape project. Also, design and create your own pot of plants to take home!

**Emergency Medical Technician:** Get a feel for work in the emergency medical field. Practice assisting people who are choking and those with other first aid emergencies. Get up close and personal in a rescue squad, apply bandages, and give injections (to an orange with kool-aid)!

This camp will provide the opportunity for students to become a "college student" for the day by exploring careers at a technical college. Students will use a computer and their creativity to work on hands-on projects that will help them realize the importance of preparing for the future now—and have fun doing it!

**CPR/First Aid:** Students will be taught the basic fundamentals for providing life-saving Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) to adults, children, and infants, along with the opportunity to also provide assistance in helping someone who is choking! Students will observe the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) trainer in an emergency situation. (Certification not included). Learn helpful first aid techniques.

**Biology:** Biology lovers this camp is for you! Students will have the opportunity to dissect a sheep brain! Students will also swab their cheek cells and look at those cells under a microscope. Experiments will also include our sense of sight, hearing, taste and smell.
