### Program and Material Fees

Program fees and material fees are set annually by the Wisconsin Technical College System Board. Material fees for lab/clinical classes vary from a minimum of \$4.50 per class to \$70.00 per credit.

### Activity Fees

Activity fees are charged for associate and technical program classes. The rate is 5.8% of program fees plus 25 cents for a total of \$8.05 per credit. The fees are used to fund non-instructional student activities, including graduation, and are administered by the Student Senate.

### Parking/Security Fees

Parking/security fees are charged for associate and technical program classes one credit and above. The fees are used to fund parking facilities and security operations.

### Vocational Adult Classes

Vocational adult classes contribute to basic education, citizenship, community safety, or a vocational objective. Unit values are used for fee calculation purposes only. Classes do not count toward a program. Senior citizens age 62 and over prior to the first day of class are exempt from Program Fees.

## Community Service Class Fees

Community Service classes are offered for personal enrichment. Unit values are used for fee calculation purposes only. Classes do not count toward a program. The NWTC Board sets rates for community service classes.

## Non-Resident Tuition

Non-resident tuition is charged to any student who has not been a bona fide resident of Wisconsin for 12 months immediately prior to the beginning of the semester. The rate is \$67.10 per credit in addition to regular tuition.

## Michigan/Wisconsin Reciprocity

Any Michigan student who is a resident of BayDeNoc and Gogebic community College Districts and the counties of Gogebic, Iron, Dickinson, Menominee, and Delta may attend NWTC under a tuition reciprocity agreement. Students admitted under this agreement will pay \$5.00 per credit in addition to the Wisconsin resident tuition rate.

## Minnesota/Wisconsin Reciprocity

Minnesota residents are considered Wisconsin residents for tuition purposes.

## Student Accident Insurance

All students enrolled in class or in a practicum program and/or other recognized student groups approved by the college will be automatically enrolled in and billed for the Wisconsin Technical Colleges Mandatory Accident Only Insurance Plan, and will be defined as a "Covered Person". Non-credit, avocational and distance learning on-line students are not eligible.

## Books and Supplies

Books and supplies are not included in tuition.
