

# 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Celebration

**Subject:** Celebration of the Birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

**Purpose:** Illustration, Creative Writing, or Narrative to share this year's theme

**Theme:** "The Time is Always Right To Do What is Right: iRespect the Dream"

**Eligibility:** Contest is open to all school-age children (K-12) living or attending school in Brown County, as well as students enrolled in a Brown County institution of higher education (separate entry form, available on website); this includes students living or attending school within the Oneida Nation. Winning and receiving an award are contingent on attending the event. Only one entry allowed per participant.

- Awards:**
- 1<sup>st</sup> Place in each grade entry level: iPad Mini & Certificate
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in each grade entry level: Wireless Tablet & Certificate
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in each grade entry level: \$50 Barnes & Noble Gift Card & Certificate

**Judging rubrics will address:**

- Relationship to theme — Formatting (following directions below) — Originality of idea
- Writing Conventions (grammar, spelling, punctuation, usage) — Voice/Creativity
- Publishable quality

**Posters\*:**

- Entries may not exceed 12" x 18"
- May be horizontal or vertical
- Must be appropriate to the subject, purpose, and theme of the contest
- Will be scored according to rubric guidelines
- Entry form must be attached to the back of the poster and signed by student

**Essays and Poems\*:**

- Must be typed and submitted on white 8½" x 11" paper **ONLY**
- Must NOT exceed 400 words
- Will be scored according to rubric guidelines
- Entry form must be attached to the back of the essay/poem and signed by student

\* Entries not meeting all formatting requirements above will not be judged!
