Access the NWTC Network from an Internet connection anywhere!

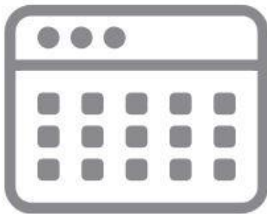
NWTC's Virtual Desktop gives you remote access to:

- Using NWTC Software (see list on the back)
- Saving files to your H: Drive
- Sending files to be printed through NWTC Print (remember to pick up within 72 hours)

Accessing the Virtual Desktop

Go to <https://vdi.nwtc.edu> using any device's browser. Choose one of the following options:

Access Via Your Web Browser



Launch Browser Access

If you don't want to use the app, click on the left icon for VMware Horizon HTML access.

NOTE: The web version does not allow you to save to a USB drive.

Download and Install the App



Download the VMWare App

Click the right icon to install the VMware Horizon app (or go to your app store to download it).

The first time on each device, you will need to click **New Server**, enter **vdi.nwtc.edu** as the name of the Connection Server, and click **Connect**. It will remember the server and give you an icon for connecting next time.

Choose to **Accept** the NWTC electronic resource guidelines.

Then **login** using your 8-digit NWTC ID number and your regular NWTC password.

Click **Student Windows 10**.

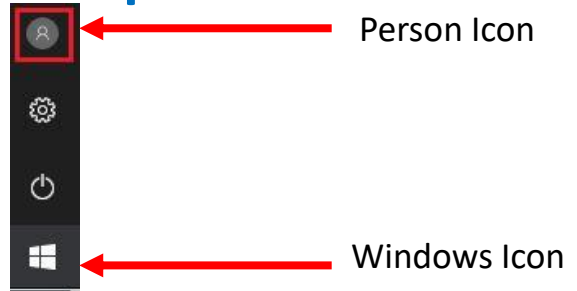


Wait . . . You will soon be connected to the Virtual Desktop, the software will be loaded, and you will see your personalized settings.
