Patsy Mink Scholarship for Women (Added on 6/2/2020)

Applicant must be a woman, at least 17 years of age and a mother, with minor children | Be pursuing a first vocational degree/certificate; OR a first associate's degree | Be low-income: all annual family income less than \$20,000 for a family of 2; less than \$24,000 for a family of 3; less than \$28,000 for a family of 4.

Jeanette Rankin Women's Scholarship (Added 6/3/2020)

Applicant must be a woman, age 35 or older (designed for women who have put their education on hold to raise a family) | low-income, a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident of the U.S.
