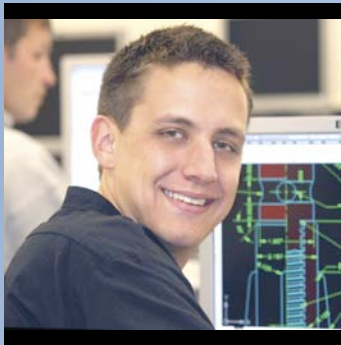

Changes in the economic climate of Northeast Wisconsin and the nation have increased enrollment by approximately 18 percent as of December 2009. More and more individuals are returning to NWTC to obtain and improve their technical skills and increase their knowledge to gain employment in a competitive labor market.

The increase in program students means additional need for Foundation funds. You have played an important role in allowing many NWTC students to continue their education. 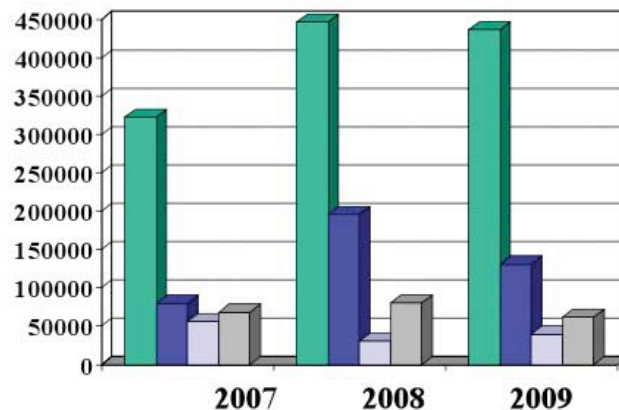
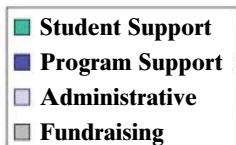
REVENUE SOURCES
