Co-work spaces offer temporary shared work areas for entrepreneurs, freelancers, remote workers, and summer visitors who work while on vacation. Co-work spaces provide a productive, functional work environment that is affordable, comfortable, and conducive to collaboration and mutual support. The center offers private offices and cubicles.

Located at 2438 S. Bay Shore Drive in Sister Bay, the center is close to downtown and adjacent to retail outlets and business support services.
