- ✓ Relocation to secure employment upon successful completion of the program is often necessary.
- ✓ It is critical to be able to obtain a CDL for this profession.
  - \$500 is the approximate cost of obtaining a CDL license.
  - This includes the cost of an optional CDL prep course offered through NWTC.
- ✓ Approximate tool cost for this program ranges from \$2000 to \$2500.
- ✓ \$100 tool deposit is needed at the mandatory orientation.
- ✓ Remaining tool balance is due the first day of school in June when the vendor delivers the tools.
- ✓ Shoe vendor requires full payment upon order if you choose to purchase them at orientation.
