For admission to this program, complete the steps listed on this page. Due to this program having several steps in the admissions process, it is important to get started on them right away. Below is the recommended order:

Submit Transcripts Have high school and college transcripts (if applicable) sent to transcripts@nwtc.edu	
Complete Assessment** (If Applicable) The assessment may be waived if your high school or college GPA is 3.0 or higher; or if you have already taken the ACT or Accuplacer. It is important that all transcripts are sent (for review) to determine if the assessment is needed.**	
Complete Algebra (NWTC Catalog #10804118) Algebra is waived for admissions purposes only if you have completed two semesters of high school algebra with a C or better, college math with a C or better, and/or college level general anatomy and physiology with a B or better. **Please note: Completing College Level Math Reasoning with a C or better is required prior to starting core program courses.	
Complete Chemistry (NWTC Catalog #10806134) Chemistry is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school chemistry with a C or better or college level chemistry with a C or better; and/or college level general anatomy and physiology with a B or better.	
Complete the HESI (Composite score of 75%+)* Visit <a href="http://www.nwtc.edu/HESI">http://www.nwtc.edu/HESI</a> for more information and study resources. Test subjects include reading, math, chemistry and anatomy & physiology. HESI dates are available in May, August, and November - it is recommended to schedule your HESI assessment several months in advance. This assessment has an associated fee (approx \$50). Please refer to the Assessment Center website for more information on testing fees.	

\* It is highly recommended to complete the General Anatomy & Physiology course PRIOR to taking the HESI if you have not recently completed an Anatomy course.
