Student Responsibilities

When you do Start College Now, you are an NWTC student.

- Know your class schedule
- Obtain any materials you need before the class starts (textbooks, tools, supplies, etc.)
- Check your NWTC email regularly
- Maintain at least a 2.0 GPA
- Reach out if you need help





Important Things to Know

- 8 week advantage
- If you want to withdraw from a class, you must submit a withdrawal form
- If you do not successfully complete your class, you may be expected to reimburse your school district
- Attendance and communication are very important
- There will be a balance posted on your account in the beginning of the semester; you can disregard this
- NWTC's academic calendar will not match your school's





Parent & Guardian Responsibilities

Help your child transition to college

- Support good attendance habits both in high school and college.
- Encourage your student to advocate for themselves.
- Comply with School District and NWTC policies on courses dropped after the start date or failed courses.
- Your child/our student must sign a release before we are able to share any enrollment information due to FERPA.




