Early Childhood Education & Early Childhood Assistant applicants are required to complete a background check and health forms due to the Field Placement course requirements.

The Practical Nursing Diploma has a limited capacity. Once it fills to capacity, students will be offered a place on a waiting list based on their eligibility date. Once all items on page 1 have been completed, you will be able to accept your position on the waitlist. Wait times change often due to fluctuations in student interest. FAQs

Q. How long is the waitlist?

A. Wait times vary due to fluctuations in student interest. You will accept your position on the waitlist WHEN all admissions items are completed. Wait times can range from 6 Months – 2 years.

Q. What if I have transfer credits?

A. A transfer review is automatically completed AFTER you have applied AND submitted your transcripts. If you had fewer then 60 college credits at a C or higher, you must also send your high school transcripts. It can take up to 2 weeks for transfer credits to be processed. If you have completed Nursing CORE courses at another college, you must be in good standing and core courses are reviewed for approval by the health division.

Q. What if I don't have a 3.0 GPA or my scores are not high?

A. It is common for students to take developmental courses to ensure their success at NWTC. Your first step is to apply and send your transcripts. Once your transcripts are processed, you may need additional testing to help determine which courses to start with!

Q. How flexible is the schedule?

A. NWTC offers a part time Nursing track at the Green Bay Campus. Due to in person clinicals and labs, you can expect 2-3 days/week in person. The part time track takes 3 semesters to complete.
