If you are a medical assistant looking to advance your career, apply your knowledge and work experience to the Practical Nursing program. There are several steps required for admission; it is important to get started on them right away. Below is the recommended order:

Submit Transcripts Send high school AND college transcripts (if applicable) to transcripts@nwtc.edu	<input type="checkbox"/>
Complete Assessment** (<i>If Applicable</i>) The assessment may be waived if your high school or college GPA is 3.0 or higher; or if you have already taken the ACT or Accuplacer. It is important that all transcripts are sent (for review) to determine if the assessment is needed.**	<input type="checkbox"/>
