


Turn on Live Captions

3.Click "Show live captions".







Translate Live Captions

- 4. Select a language.






Adjust your PowerPoint View

LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The region served by Northeast Wisconsin Technical College occupies the ancestral home of the Menominee Nation, who have persisted here in Northeast Wisconsin from before recorded history to the present day. The College's Green Bay campus exists upon lands ceded from the Menominee Tribe to the Oneida Nation. We acknowledge this land we stand upon today as sacred, historical, and significant to the Menominee and Oneida Nations, as are the lands of all First Nations People.



"occupies" demonstrates an acknowledgment of stewardship rather than ownership that is important to Native people



"persisted" acknowledges the struggle and resilience of the Menominee people to continue to exist in the only place they have ever called home as described in "from before recorded history"



honors the transfer of stewardship between tribes, rather than highlighting the removal of tribes



this is a statement meant to be inclusive to all of Wisconsin's many tribes that at one time called our district home

Dates

Students apply to their high schools by the following dates:

October 1
For spring courses

March 1
For fall courses

11 & 12th Graders

Students can apply as early as 10^{th} grade to take courses in 11^{th} grade.

18 Credits

Students in public schools can earn a minimum of 18 college credits at no cost to students or families.

Registering

Students will: Register for classes.

Get their textbooks.

Share their schedule with high school counselors.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

A SUCCESSFUL STUDENT:

- Knows their course schedule.
- Understands <u>NWTC's calendar</u> is different from their high school calendar.
- Attends class.
- Meets assignment and exam due dates.
- Asks their NWTC instructors and high school counselors for help.
- Checks their NWTC accounts daily: Email, <u>Canvas</u>, <u>Student Portal</u>, <u>Starfish</u>.
- Maintains a GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- Adheres to the <u>student handbook</u>.



A CLOSER LOOK - PART 1 OF 2

ACADEMIC TERMS

- Many courses are 8 weeks long.
- Some courses are a full semester.
- Course start- and enddates will be different from your high school.

CHANGING COURSES

- As a college student, be aware of the policy for <u>dropping a course</u>.
- Communicate with your high school counselor about any changes to your courses or schedule.

STARFISH - EARLY ALERT SYSTEM

- Instructors communicate about your course performance with "flags" and "kudos".
- You may be connected to College resources through "referrals".
- Check your NWTC email daily for alerts.



A CLOSER LOOK - PART 2 OF 2

GRADES

- Do well in courses so you can continue with a strong college GPA.
- If you are not successful in a class, your school district may ask you to pay for the course.

TUITION

- Start College Now tuition is paid by your K12 school district.
- Any required books and materials are also paid by your K12 school district.

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

- Protects college student privacy.
- NWTC can only share information directly with students and NOT with family members, unless you submit an <u>Authorization to Release</u> <u>Confidential Information.</u>
- NWTC may share limited information with K12 school districts.



STUDENT SERVICES

- <u>Disability Services</u> students must reach out and we encourage you to do so!
- Academic Coaching and Tutoring ask for support early
- <u>Library</u> technology, research, materials
- Admissions Advisors available to meet virtually or in-person
- Online Orientation find this in your student portal
- <u>Career Services</u> explore your interests & what you can do with your courses
- <u>Student Involvement</u> participate in events, clubs, study abroad, and more!



SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

NURSING ASSISTANT (CNA)

- Students taking Nursing Assistant must also apply to the program.
- You can find key information about how to apply <u>here</u>.
- Students in courses hosted at a high school will be registered by College staff.

ACADEMIES

 Students participating in Northwoods, Ahnapee, or City Stadium Academies cannot register for courses because they are hidden to the public – NWTC will do that for you.

HERE'S HOW TO GET STARTED:

1. Create Your NWTC Account

If you don't have a student ID yet, go to student 'Create an NWTC Account."

2. Log In to the Student Portal

Use your NWTC ID to log in at <u>student-portal.nwtc.edu</u>. You'll need to download the Microsoft Authenticator app on your mobile device to complete the login process. Learn how <u>here</u>.

3. Enroll in Your Approved Courses

Follow these step-by-step instructions to enroll in your approved courses → Enrolling Instructions

*Note: Because you're a high school student, the registration system may not automatically recognize that you've met the prerequisite requirements. If you receive an error saying you're not eligible to enroll, follow these override instructions to request permission to register > Override Instructions


