Competitive Application Process:

Applications that have all admissions requirements met on March 1st or September 30th will be forwarded to the selection committee for review. Candidates are ranked on their HESI scores and essay. The highest-ranking candidates will be offered a place on the program wait list.

Attend:

Information Session: The purpose of the session is to give interested students in-depth information about the program, the career, and admissions requirements. Sign up at nwtc.edu/DentalHygienist.

Complete:

- Algebra: One semester in college OR two semesters in high school with a C or better
- Biology: One semester in college OR two semesters in high school with a C or better
- Chemistry: One semester in college OR two semesters in high school with a C or better
- Health Education System Inc. (HESI) Admissions Assessment: Earn a cumulative score of 80 or higher. Test includes: reading comprehension, math, chemistry and anatomy and physiology.
- Essay: Complete essay in the Assessment Center at any NWTC campus.
