



## **Advanced EMT Health Portal Requirements**

### **CPR CERTIFICATION**

#### **Submit your CPR certification**

The following are Department of Health Services (DHS)-approved providers and courses approved for emergency medical responders, emergency medical technicians (EMTs), and paramedics and other healthcare providers operating as a legal crew member of an ambulance:
