<b>Submit Transcripts</b> Send high school and college transcripts (if applicable) to <a href="mailto:transcripts@nwtc.edu">transcripts@nwtc.edu</a>	
Complete Assessment** (If Applicable) The assessment may be waived if your high school or college GPA is 3.0 or higher; or if you have already taken the ACT or Accuplacer. It is important that all transcripts are sent (for review) to determine if the assessment is needed.**	
Complete Chemistry (NWTC Catalog #10806134) Chemistry is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school chemistry with a C or better or college chemistry with a C or better.	
<b>Complete Biology</b> (NWTC Catalog #10806177) Biology is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school biology with a C or better or college biology with a C or better.	
Complete Algebra (NWTC Catalog #10834111) Algebra is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school algebra with a C or better, college math with a C or better, and/or college general anatomy and physiology with a B or better.	
<b>Complete Advanced Math</b> (NWTC Catalog #10834111) Algebra is waived if you have completed two semesters of high school Algebra 2, Geometry, Advanced Algebra or higher with a C or better OR college math with a C or better.	

The Medical Laboratory Program has a limited capacity. Once it fills to capacity, students will be offered a place on a waiting list based on their eligibility date. Once all items on page 1 have been completed, you will be able to accept your position on the waitlist. Wait times change often due to fluctuations in student interest.
